# Taking Holiday in Term Time

Last year's attendance for the whole school was just 91.6%, which is extremely low. The national average is 97%, which is also the expectation in this school. You have a legal duty to make sure your child attends school regularly and punctually. The school and the Local Authority monitor your child's attendance and will take action if it is poor. The Government recommends that family holidays are taken outside of school terms. Headteachers will sometimes give permission for a pupil to go on holiday during term time. They will consider the reasons for the holiday, the pupil's past attendance, and the effects the absence will have on the pupil's learning. But will not normally give permission simply because holidays cost less during term time. Headteachers have the discretion to grant leave, but they should only do so in exceptional circumstances. If a head teacher grants a leave request, it will be for them to determine the length of time that the child can be away from school. It is, however, unlikely to be granted for the purposes of a family holiday. Parents can be fined for taking their child on holiday during term time without consent from the school.

**Warning** - If you take your child out of school without permission you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to the education Welfare Service who may decide to prosecute. A conviction may result in a fine of up to £2,500, a prison sentence of up to three months or both. Alternatively, a penalty notice may be issued, this carries a fine of £60 per child if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice will result in Court action.

#### School Uniform

Now that we are fully settled into the Autumn term, and with half term coming up, I realise that it may be that some parents may be thinking about replacing uniform that no longer fits. Therefore, I wanted to take the opportunity to send this reminder of our uniform expectations. They are as follows:

- Sky blue polo shirt (not white), preferably with the Trannack logo
- Royal blue Trannack crew-neck sweater
- Royal blue Trannack cardigan
- Grey trousers, uniform/taylored shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- White or grey socks/grey tights
- Plain black shoes
- PE kit (to be worn on PE and sports club days only): royal blue hoodie and sky-blue t-shirt (both preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms.


