School Meals & School Census

Next Thursday (5th Oct) the school has to complete the termly census. On this day the amount of school meals taken by the children in Reception to Yr2 determines how much funding the school receives for school meals for the coming year. On census day Chartwell's are providing a menu which they think will encourage children to take a meal (to help the schools gain the funding). Please encourage your children to take a meal on census day especially if they are in YrR, Yr1 or Yr2.
