#### **INSET Days**

#### School Meals & School Census

Next Thursday (5<sup>th</sup> Oct) the school has to complete the termly census. On this day the amount of school meals taken by the children in Reception to Yr2 determines how much funding the school receives for school meals for the coming year. On census day Chartwell's are providing a menu which they think will encourage children to take a meal (to help the schools gain the funding). There will be a choice of burger in a bun with chips, Quorn hot dog with chips or jacket potato with cheese &/or beans. There will be no pasta on this day. Please encourage your children to take a meal on census day especially if they are in YrR, Yr1 or Yr2.

#### Woodlands
