KNOW: Children of any age can find things online that upset, confuse or worry them. This can lead to a whole barrage of questions about anything from violent YouTube videos to world news, sex or extremism.

REACT: Take your lead from them: ask them to explain what they've seen. They will have questions, so offer straightforward, honest answers (while being careful not to overwhelm them) to help them deal with whatever has upset them.


RECOVER: Leave the conversation open and reassure your child that they can come back to you if they have further questions or concerns. See the Digital Parenting online hub for more advice.

Devon and Cornwall Police's Lift Legend Campaign

Devon and Cornwall Police's Lift Legend campaign is returning again this December with almost 80 licensed premises set to offer free soft drinks to designated drivers over the festive period.

Drink and drug driving is one of the 'fatal five' causes of serious injuries and deaths on roads in South West England. Last winter, Devon & Cornwall Police arrested 952 people for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. In a bid to tackle drink and drug driving, Devon & Cornwall Police has announced the return of its popular drink drive campaign, Lift Legend; an initiative that looks to reward designated drivers with free drinks as a 'thank you' for getting their friends, colleagues and family members home safely. Lift Legend will run from Friday 1 December 2023 until Monday 1 January 2024. Drivers buying a soft drink in one of the participating venues will receive a voucher to get their second drink free of charge.
