Dear Parents/Carers

Now that the Christmas dust is just about settled, I would like to say Happy New Year and wish you all the best for 2024. Although we've only been back for two days, we are fully into the swing of things and I'm thrilled with how well the children have settled back into school already. We're looking forward to a spring term packed with interesting new topics, hard work and plenty of fun, with trips to look forward to, plus Bikeability, Woodlands Days and swimming starting.

I would also like to take this opportunity to reiterate the importance of attendance and uniform:

- Attendance: While genuine illnesses cannot be helped and we do not expect poorly children to attend school, our current whole school attendance of 92% continues to be a concern when compared with the national expectation of 95%. Please continue to make every effort you can to ensure your child is at school every day during term time.

- Uniform: At Trannack, we believe that our uniform is a part of the whole picture of creating a school environment in which children can confidently thrive. As such, I would like to remind all parents of our uniform expectations and ask that you do all you can to ensure that your child wears our uniform correctly, especially when replacing old uniform that your child has outgrown. Our uniform is as follows:

- Sky blue polo shirt (not white), preferably with the Trannack logo
- Royal blue Trannack crew-neck sweater
- Royal blue Trannack cardigan
- Grey trousers, uniform/taylored shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- White or grey socks/grey tights
- Plain black shoes
- PE kit (to be worn on PE days **ONLY**): royal blue Trannack hoodie, sky-blue t-shirt (preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms.

Swimming – Godrevy Class – Starting Friday 12th January

This year each class will swim for 5 sessions. Godrevy class are swimming for the first sessions which will start on Friday of next week (12th January). Portreath class will be swimming from Friday 23rd February for 5 weeks and Praa Sands will start swimming on 19th April for 5 weeks. We ask that parents pay a contribution towards swimming of £5 per child via ParentPay.

Although swimming is a statutory part of the curriculum there is no funding to support this. Therefore, if we have to subsidise it out of the school funds it is taking money from other areas of the school budget and supporting resources, which is why we depend on parental contributions.


Penlee Lifeboat Museum - Tuesday 9th January
