The Start of the Day

May we remind you that children should be in school by 8:40am for registration at 8:45am. Any child arriving after 8:45am will be recorded as late. Portreath Class Visit to Penlee House Gallery & Museum

We began the day applying our previous learning by using a timeline to order the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic, Bronze Age and Iron Age periods. We then looked at replica artefacts and used our knowledge to decide what they were and which periods they came from. The children made some fantastic observations. After this, we went into the museum where we could look at artefacts from all the way back in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. It was amazing to see these artefacts some of which were even discovered in Trannack.

The children were superstars all day and were complimented on their behaviour and manners by the team at Penlee House. A fantastic way to end our topic! Well done! Portreath - we are so proud of you!
