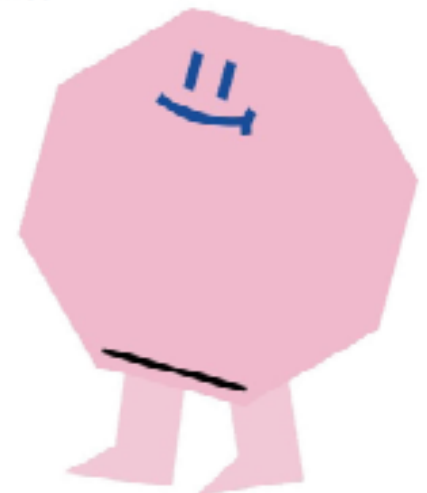
We would love for parents/carers in Cornwall to join us for our first engagement workshop.
