Eden - Tomorrow

Please ensure that Portreath children arrive at school tomorrow by 8:30am prompt. We are hoping to get on the road as soon after as possible to make the most of the day. Children will need a packed lunch, snack and drink in a backpack. The trip will cost £7.95 per child, which can be paid via ParentPay. Thank you!

Swimming

Tomorrow is the last session for Godrevy class, after half term Portreath class will be swimming, the same arrangements will take place. Children will travel to the pool via minibus during the afternoon and we request that parents collect their children from the pool at 3:15pm. There will be 5 sessions in total starting on Friday 23rd February and ending on Friday 22nd March inc. The requested contribution is £25. This can be paid via ParentPay. We would be grateful if contributions for Godrevy class sessions could be paid as soon as possible. Although swimming is a statutory part of the curriculum there is no funding to support this. Therefore, if we have to subsidise it out of the school funds it is taking money from other areas of the school budget and supporting resources, which is why we depend on parental contributions.
