1. DESIGNATE A TRUSTED ADULT



It's vital that children feel safe and know that there's someone they can always go to for help if they need it. Schedule consistent times for the child to develop a relationship with this person – ideally through play and games – allowing trust to grow and ensuring that the child is more likely to come forward if anything is wrong, rather than hiding their emotions. National Online Safety - Teaching children to self-regulate online Children need to learn to understand and recognise their emotions, while finding healthy ways to process them. Emotional self-regulation depends heavily on age and development and nurturing these important skills can be hugely beneficial.

This is the first of the top ten tips for supporting children with their self-regulation.
