8. NURTURE INDEPENDENCE

If you feel it's appropriate, let children try out these strategies alone. Always offer them a choice: they could listen to music when they're feeling stressed, for example, or they could write down their worries or draw something to represent how they feel. This may take time for the child to get used to, so be patient. Encourage them to share any helpful strategies with a trusted adult.

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National Online Safety - Teaching children to self-regulate online Children need to learn to understand and recognise their emotions, while finding healthy ways to process them. Emotional self-regulation depends heavily on age and development and nurturing these important skills can be hugely beneficial.

This is the eight of the top ten tips for supporting children with their self-regulation.
