This roughly equates to a commitment of 25-30 hours each academic year as a minimum. Clickbait is a controversial online marketing strategy which uses sensationalist (and frequently misleading) headlines to encourage engagement with an article, image or video - often playing on users' emotions and curiosity, while much of the actually content is of questionable accuracy. Clickbait is also sometimes used to disguise scams, phishing sites and malware.
