School Uniform

As we begin to think about the end of the year, I hope that this is a useful time to update you on our uniform for next year. Essentially, it is staying the same as this year, with the small change that, rather than separating the crew neck jumpers and hoodies for normal uniform/PE kit, the children can wear either at any point, recognising that for some children, the hoodies are a lot more comfortable. Therefore, these are the uniform expectations for September 2024:

- · Sky blue polo shirt, preferably with the Trannack logo
- · Royal blue Trannack crew-neck sweater or hoodie
- · Royal blue Trannack cardigan
- · Grey trousers, uniform/tailored shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- · Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- · White or grey socks/grey tights
- · Plain black shoes
- PE kit (to be worn on PE days): sky-blue t-shirt (preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms.

Some of the children in Godrevy invented their own board games, which they played once they were finished.


Forest School Club




School Governors

We are currently recruiting governors for our local governing committee (LGC). We need to fill parent and community categories. School governors are vital in ensuring that schools achieve the best possible outcomes for children and young people. There are no specific qualifications or requirements for the role every governing board needs a balance and diversity of knowledge, skills and experience. You don't need to



have a background in education. You will be asked to attend 6 meetings per year, from 4.30-6pm approximately, and would be required to carry out one school visit each term. This roughly equates to a commitment of 25-30 hours each academic year as a minimum. Clickbait is a controversial online marketing strategy which uses sensationalist (and frequently misleading) headlines to encourage engagement with an article, image or video – often playing on users' emotions and curiosity, while much of the actually content is of questionable accuracy. Clickbait is also sometimes used to disguise scams, phishing sites and malware.
