### The Newsletter

In order to save on paper and printing, and support a sustainable future, there will no longer be a printed newsletter. It will be uploaded to Dojo and the school website only from now on. To find it on the school website you just need to go to the front page and scroll down to 'News'.

## Class Dojo

Class Dojo is the main way that we communicate with parents at Trannack. Here you will hear about what your child is learning in their class and receive important updates about what is going on in school as a whole. Teachers will also use this to send individual messages to you regarding your child. Please try to check Dojo regularly so that you feel up to date. If you are not yet signed up to Class Dojo, please make your child's class teacher aware of this and they will help you get signed up.

## Woodlands Days

We will be endeavouring to plan woodlands days once per half term throughout the year. The first of these will be arranged for the week beginning 30th September. Please look out for more information coming soon about the specific day of your child's class's activities.

## Surfing

The first surfing session will take place on Monday of next week the  $16^{th}$  September. Children will be transported by minibus to Gwithian Beach for 3:45 - 4:00pm. Mrs Ash will be accompanying the group and driving the minibus. Once finished children will be ready for collection from Gwithian Beach (Sunset Surf Café) for 6pm or school at 6:30pm. The price is £10 per session (£50 in total). The surf club is offered at 60% less than their normal surf lesson prices and school subsidises the cost further using sports premium. We ask that 100% of the sessions be paid for in advance via ParentPay once it has been uploaded to the system. If your child has an inhaler please ensure they have it with them during these sessions should they need it. I'm afraid surfing is now fully subscribed, there are no more places available unless someone changes their mind.

## Sailing

Sailing club will commence on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September, for children in Yr4, 5 and 6. There are 5 sessions in total, the price per session is £4.50 (£22.50 in total) this has been subsidised by the sailing club. Full payment will need to be made in advance via ParentPay once it has been uploaded to the system. Parents are required to drop off outside the Ferry Boat Inn on the Helford River at 4pm and pick up at 6pm. Before the sessions commence on Thursday the Sailing Trust require the 'Health & Water Confidence Declaration' to be completed by every family. ## Your child's annual nasal flu vaccination is now due

Kernow Health's School Age Immunisation Service is delivering the nasal flu immunisation programme in Cornwall's and Devon's schools on behalf of NHS England & Improvement. Flu can be a very unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

In 2024/25 all children in Primary Schools from Reception to year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please enter <a href="www.nhs.uk/child-flu">www.nhs.uk/child-flu</a> to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. We are due to visit your child's school on Friday 4th October 2024. Please submit your consent form by midday on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please telephone 01872 221105 for Cornwall schools and 01392 342678 for Devon schools and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years you must opt into the programme. If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated.

If your child becomes wheezy or has their asthma medication increased after you submit this form, please contact us on the numbers above.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, it will help us if you still complete and submit the consent form giving the reason. This will help us to plan and develop the service. Please tell us if you need this information in a different format.
