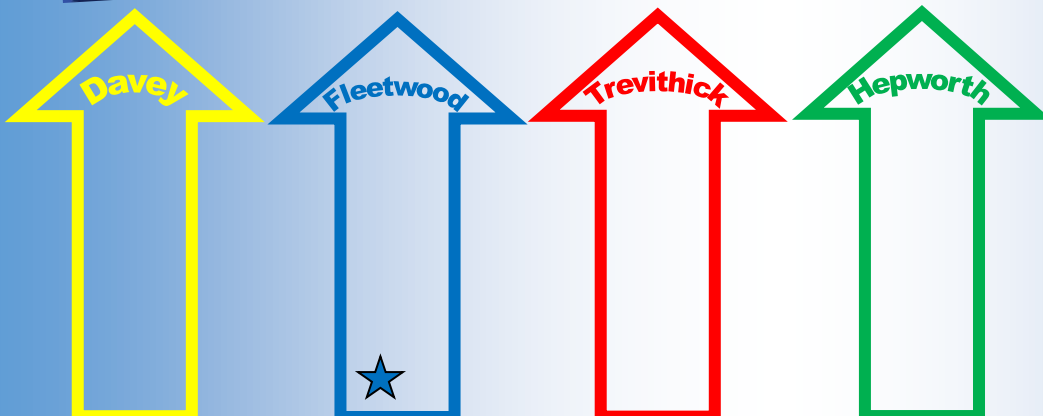
Lost & Found

Spy Master: First Blood by Jan Burchett



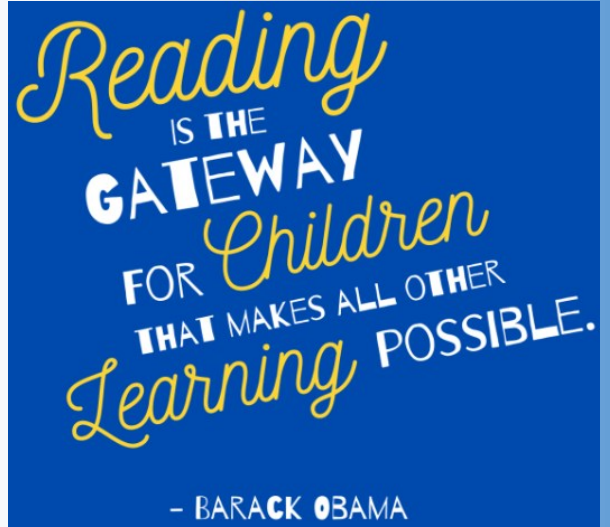

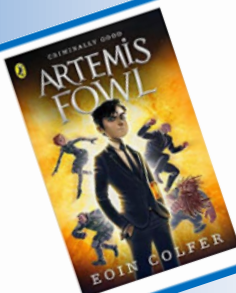
