**Health Information** - The National Childhood Measurement appointments have been booked for Tues 25th March for children in YrR & Yr6.

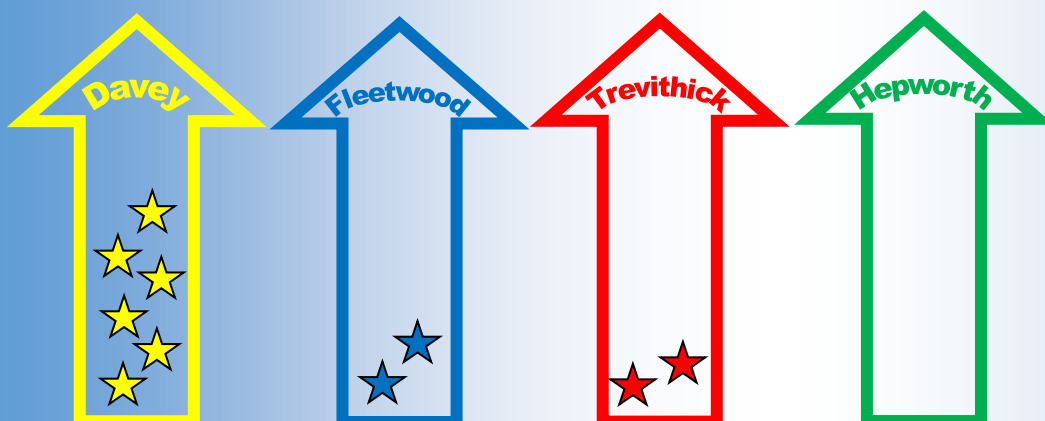
