End of Term Parents' Assembly - This will take place at 9am on the morning of 4th April. We are unable to hold it at the end of the day as Portreath class will be swimming.


Praa Sands Swimming - Children in Praa Sands class will be swimming for 4 sessions next term. The sessions will commence on Friday 2nd May until Friday 23rd May inclusive. The swimming contribution will be £20 per child. A letter will be sent home with a reply slip so that you can indicate if you would like to collect your child directly from the pool after swimming.

The National Childhood Measurement appointments took place on Tuesday of this week. All children who took part were given a letter for their parents.


