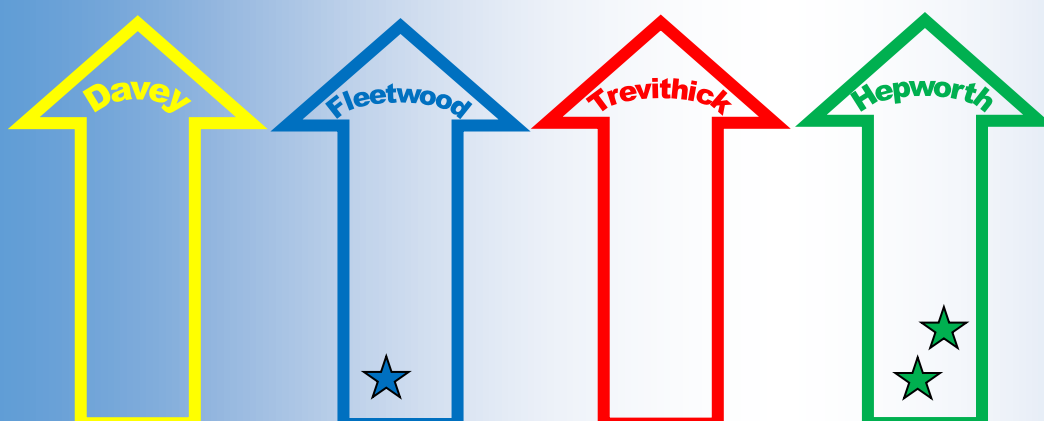

Fun Facts about Books

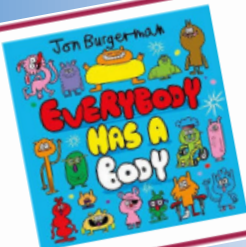
in the medieval period, the most common book covering material was leather—animal leather, to be precise. However, the Harvard Library contains several books bound in human skin! One of them is *Des destinées de l'ame*, which has been sitting in Harvard's Houghton Library since the 1930s.
