The School Day

- · Wake and shake starts at 8:30 and is free of charge. Doors open at 8:40am for registration and close at 8:50am. Children arriving between 8:50am and 9:00am will need to come to the office to sign in, they will be marked down as 'late'. Children arriving after close of registration at 9:00am, will be marked down as 'late after close of registration'.
- Lunch time commences at 12:10pm and ends at 1:10pm. Little Learners leaving at lunch time are to be collected at 12:00noon.
- The end of the school day is 3:15pm, unless you are using Kids' Club, please see information below regarding this.

Absence - If your child is absent from school it is especially important that you call school first thing in the morning to explain the reason. You can leave an answerphone message or send an email to trannacksecretary@croftymat.org (Please don't email the named school emails as these can be missed on days when a member of staff isn't in). Please ensure you give a brief description of the illness. Due to safeguarding compliance, if we don't get a message from parents and cannot get hold of you by 12noon we are obliged to come to the house to check that all is well. This is something which we would all prefer to avoid.

Breakfast and Afterschool Wraparound - Times and charges

- Breakfast club (Early Bird) will continue to open at 8am Monday to Friday with a standard charge of £2:25.
- We are happy to announce that we have extended Kids' Club, our after-school provision, to 5:15pm, Monday to Thursday. We hope that the extra 15 minutes will help working parents.
- There is a minimum charge of £2.25 for the first ½ hour of after school provision and then every ½ hour thereafter. For example, if a child stays until 4:15pm the amount payable will be £4.50, or £6.75 if they stay until 4:45pm. Please try to book a wraparound place in advance so that we can ensure provision is sufficiently staffed, ideally by Friday noon for the following week if at all possible. Many thanks for your cooperation. Please be aware that consistent lateness collecting children may incur the minimum charge of £2.25.

Uniform - Having a uniform is an important part of our school identity which helps every child feel a part of the community and contributes to a positive atmosphere for learning. Every effort has been made to ensure that the uniform is affordable and easily sourced from our suppliers (please see page 3) and local supermarkets. There are also some items of clothing in the entrance porch which are free of charge, some are new, some partly worn. Below is an updated uniform list as was sent out in the summer term:

- Sky blue polo shirt (not white), preferably with the Trannack logo
- Royal blue Trannack crew-neck sweater or hoodie
- Royal blue cardigan, preferably with the Trannack logo
- Dark grey or black trousers (no leggings please), uniform/tailored shorts
- Dark grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- White or grey socks/grey tights
- Plain black shoes (no crocs, sandals, etc)

PE kit to be worn on PE days (Mondays and Tuesdays for all pupils) - Royal blue Trannack hoodie, sky-blue t-shirt (preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms. See page 5 for information on uniform suppliers.

Please ensure all school clothing is labelled, including coats and shoes as children often have the same or very similar clothing items.

Class Dojo - This is the online platform we use for most of our school to home communication and for updates on learning that is taking place in both classrooms. Please let us know if you are having any trouble logging in or accessing information that is posted on Class Dojo either by contacting your child's class teacher or the school office.

Headlice - Please ensure that children with long hair tie it back. We would appreciate it if parents are constantly vigilant on checking for headlice. It is much easier to 'nip it in the bud' if they are detected early.

After School Clubs - These will be available week commencing Monday 15th September. Further information and sign up forms will follow next week.

Mellow Mondays - We will be continuing our 'soft start' to the week on Mondays, using these times to teach a combination of reading, art, PE and woodlands activities until breaktime.

Wrap Around Care outstanding payments - Please ensure you pay for outstanding Wrap Around Care invoices for Jun/July as soon as possible via ParentPay. As this is part of the 2024/25 financial year and would be most helpful to the finance office at the Trust if it is settled promptly due to their end of year audit. Thank you!

Emergency Alerts System - On Sunday 7 September at 3pm, the UK government will test the Emergency Alerts system. The test will be sent to all compatible 4G and 5G mobile phones and tablets across the UK. You will hear a loud siren-like sound, vibration, and a message will appear on the screen confirming that this is a test. The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds. You will not need to take any further action.
