
Surf Club - Date for surf club are: Tues 16th, 23rd and 30th September and 7th, 14th and 21st October. The cost of surfing is just £80 per child instead of £108, this is partly due to the subsidy using our Sports Premium. Once we know who wishes to sign up for the club we will put the invoice on ParentPay as this needs to be paid in one lump sum in advance. **Please note that children will need to be collected from Gwithian at 6pm not 6:30pm.**

Photograph Consent - We have now pushed out photo consent requests to all parents via Arbor. It would be much appreciated if you could log in and tick the consents that you are happy with. In order to do this you will need to download the Arbor app to your mobile. Please note that the school newsletter is uploaded to the school website as a PDF document, please bear this in mind when giving consent to photographs in the newsletter. The School Day - Wake and shake starts at 8:30 and is free of charge. Doors open at 8:40am for registration and close at 8:50am. Children arriving between 8:50am and 9:00am will need to come to the office to sign in, they will be marked down as 'late'. Children arriving after close of registration at 9:00am, will be marked down as 'late after close of registration'. Lunch time commences at 12:10pm and ends at 1:10pm. Little Learners leaving at lunch time are to be collected at 12:00noon. The end of the school day is 3:15pm, unless you are using Kids' Club or an after school club.

This morning in Praa Sands we all showed great listening skills and followed instructions to draw one of our favourite characters, SpongeBob! Check out these great pieces of art!















These combs are brilliant at helping to get rid of headlice. They have long spiral teeth made of metal which drag the lice and eggs from the hair. They can be purchased online and in some chemists.

Wet Combing

Lice and nits can be removed by wet combing.

You can buy a special fine-toothed comb (detection comb) online or from pharmacies to remove head lice and nits.

There may be instructions on the pack, but usually you:

- wash hair with ordinary shampoo
- apply lots of conditioner (any conditioner will do)
- comb the whole head of hair, using the detection comb, from the roots to the ends

It usually takes about 10 minutes to comb short hair, and 20 to 30 minutes for long, frizzy or curly hair. When you've finished combing the hair, comb through all the hair again for a second time.

Do wet combing on days 1, 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched head lice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17.





The Facts about Headlice

- **1. Lice like clean hair more than dirty hair.** So, showering alone won't get rid of them.
- **2.** It is estimated that 1 in 4 children will get lice sometime in their life. This is based off the fact that there are more than 12 million reported cases of lice in the US every year. So, if you or your child get lice, don't feel alone. It's far from unusual.
- **3. Lice are tiny, wingless, and crawl very quickly.** They are only about 2mm-4mm in size. Lice are not able to fly, hop or jump from person to person.
- **4. Lice are blood-sucking parasites.** They need a human host to survive. Once off of their human host, they will only survive for 24-72 hours.
- **5. People get lice from other people.** This could mean close human contact or sharing personal items with an infected person.
