**Photograph Consent** - Now that we have adopted the new parental photograph consents within Arbor for the children, in line with all Crofty schools, we will no longer be publishing photographs of children in the newsletter or on Dojo until consent has been given on Arbor. With this in mind, we would be very grateful if you take a look at the consents which need authorising there are various different options. Class Dojo is under the option Learning Journeys, as this is the same sort of platform, which is only accessed by school parents who have signed up for it. It is not shared outside of these families. The newsletter often has photographs in it which have been on class Dojo. The difference with the newsletter is that it is published on the school website. We generally don't put names next to the photographs in the newsletter (if we did it would only be a first name), you have to click on the newsletter within the site to be able to see the photographs. It's important that you check the options and give consent to those that you agree with. If you don't want to give consent please choose the decline option rather than ignoring it.

**Annual Consent Form** - A link to the new online version of this form will be sent to parents early next week and will allow you to consent to various school visits and journeys. It will also enable you to give consent for your child to take part in forest school activities, swimming sessions, watch PG or U rated films etc.

**Trannack Open Day** - Our open day takes place on Wednesday 22nd October between 10am and 12

**Open Afternoon** - Parents and families are invited to our open afternoon on Wednesday 22nd October at 2pm. This will enable your child/children to share their work with you and for you to hear what our vision and hopes are for the year ahead (and beyond).

**Year 5/6 Residential** - This year's residential will take place at Porthpean Outdoor Education Centre, St Austell, from Wednesday 3rd June to Friday 5th June 2026. The total cost for this year's trip will be £210. An initial 'expression of interest' letter was sent home earlier this week. Please return the slip attached to the letter as soon as possible if you would like your child to attend this year's fantastic residential! Following this, a £50 non-refundable deposit will be required by February 2026.

**Fundraising update** - As you will already be aware, we are currently in the process of attempting to raise money to buy and install a new trim trail for the main school field. The total cost of acquiring this type of equipment is considerable (between £10,000-£20,000). We have applied for lottery funding but need to make some amendments to our application before trying again. Unfortunately, this is a slow process! However, we would like to look at other ways to raise funds for this, such as through and sponsorship events that we plan to hold throughout the year. Please look out for more information about these in the coming weeks.

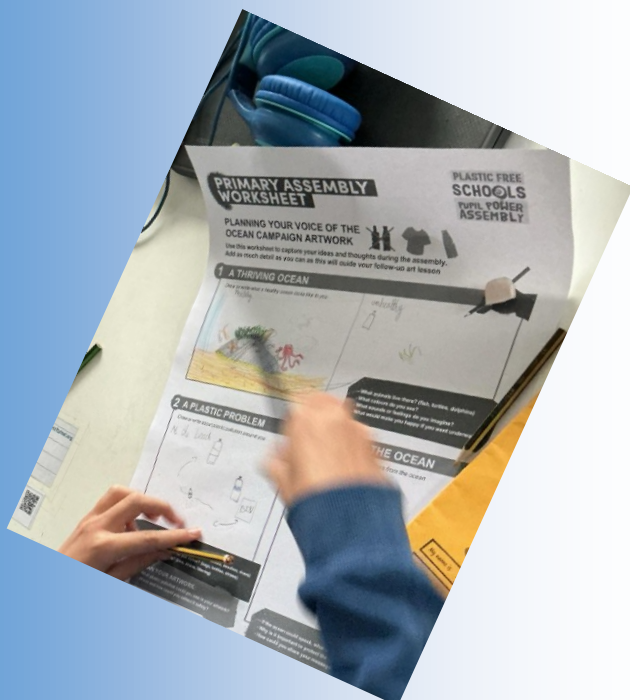
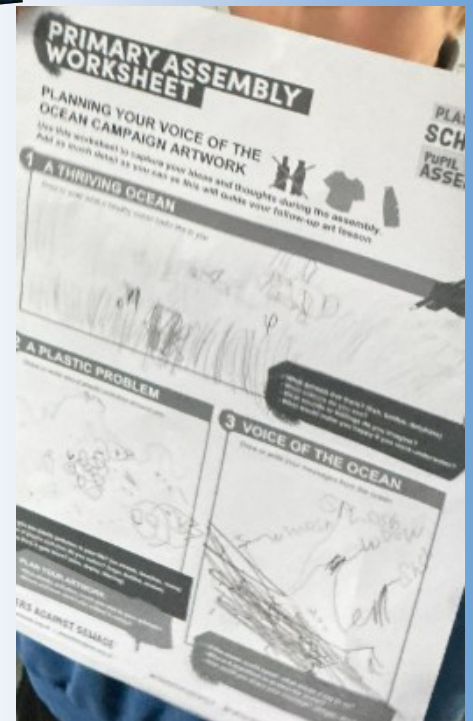
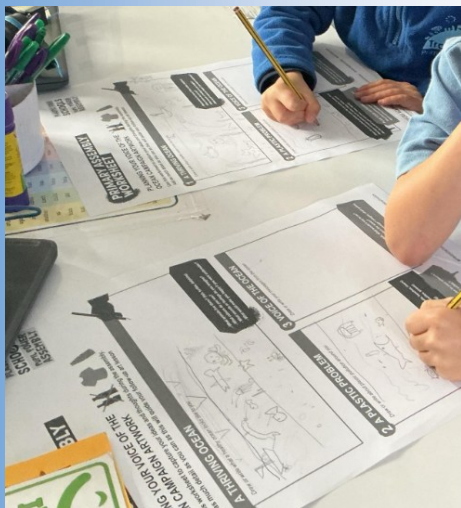
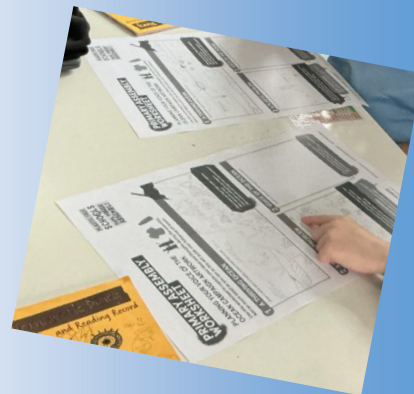
