We will be having our first sponsored event to raise money towards a new trim trail on Saturday 8th November. This will be a walk around Penrose on the morning of Saturday 8th November to raise money towards. We are proposing to begin our walk from the Fairground Car park in Helston, making a loop around the Penrose estate to Loe Bar and then back to Helston, totalling around 6 miles/10km. We would love to see as many Trannack families there as possible! Sponsorship links and specific details will be sent out shortly.



IMPORTANT forms - We would like to apologise for all the forms which are in need of completing at the moment. However, please try to have them completed ASAP as these are either to keep your child safe or to help make their learning more interesting:

- **Flu Immunisations** - These will take place during the afternoon of Thursday 13th November. A letter was sent home on Friday. This will also be posted on Dojo, which will enable you to click the link to complete the form. You must complete the online form, without this your child will be unable to have the immunisation. You can also click the link here which will take you to the application for consent: <https://www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu> You will also need this code to access the form: EE144003. The form on Dojo has links to further information regarding the vaccine.
- **Photograph Consent** - It would be most helpful if you could take a little time to log into Arbor to choose your photograph consents. There are various different options. Class Dojo is under the option Learning Journeys, as this is the same sort of platform, which is only accessed by school parents who have signed up for it. It is not shared outside of these families. The newsletter often has photographs in it which have been on class Dojo. The difference with the newsletter is that it is published on the school website. We generally don't put names next to the photographs in the newsletter (if we did it would only be a first name), you have to click on the newsletter within the site to be able to see the photographs. It's important that you check the options and give consent to those that you agree with. If you don't want to give consent please choose the decline option rather than ignoring it. Please see the information below detailing how to set up your Arbor account if you haven't yet logged in. **How to set up your Arbor account:**
 - ⇒ Go to <https://trannack-primary-school.uk.arbor.sc>
 - ⇒ Click **Forgot your password?** To finish setting up your account.
 - ⇒ If this doesn't work, it may be because we have a different email address on the system. Your accounts have already been created using the email address we have on record for you. Please contact the school office and we will check this for you.
 - ⇒ The **Arbor Parent App** can be downloaded from the **Google Play Store** (Android) or the **Apple App Store** (iPhone).
 - ⇒ Arbor also has a helpful guide here: [Getting started - Log into the Parent Portal and the Parent App](#)
- **Annual Consent Form** - When you get chance we would really appreciate it if you could complete the new online version of this form which was posted on Dojo earlier this week. This will enable you to give consent for your child to take part in forest school activities, swimming sessions, watch PG or U rated films etc.

Trannack Tidy Up Session - In preparation for our Open Day, we are planning on having another clean and tidy up around the school. This will take place on Saturday 18th October between 10am and 1pm. We would love to see you if you're able to help.



Trannack Open Day - Our open day takes place on Wednesday 22nd October between 10am and 12.

Open Afternoon - Parents and families are invited to our open afternoon on Wednesday 22nd October at 2pm. This will enable your child/children to share their work with you and for you to hear what our vision and hopes are for the year ahead (and beyond).

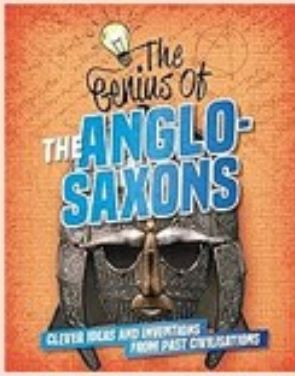
