Dear Parents and Carers

This half term has definitely started with a bang (quite literally with it being bonfire night!). Unfortunately, there has been a lot of illness, with various bugs going round, but all the children have been working hard to get back up to speed after the half term break.

I'm thrilled at the amount of money we've already raised towards a new trim trail, with over £700 raised through sponsorship in addition to the £2000 pledged by CROFTY and £1500 by the FTS. We've really got some momentum now working towards our target!

Fundraising - We are holding our first sponsored event of the year to raise money for a new trim trail over the weekend, with walks taking place at 10am on Saturday and Sunday around the Penrose estate. *Please note: Mrs Thomas has also kindly arranged the alternative walk for Sunday 9th November for those unable to make Saturday 8th. Please speak to her for further details.* There are two ways to collect sponsorship: The first is via Go Fund Me. All your sponsors need to do is go to: <https://gofund.me/9f0520e51> and transfer the amount they would like to give. The second option is to complete sponsorship forms (sent out earlier this week) and collect cash to hand in to the school office. Thank you to the FTS for their support in organising all our fundraising events.



Sickness - There are a few bugs going around school at the moment, including a tummy bug. Please remind children to wash their hands well after using the bathroom to help reduce the spread of germs. If your child has a tummy bug they need to stay at home for 48 hours after the last bout of diarrhoea or sickness. Please also ensure you call the school and leave a message or email to let us know the reason for absence.

The Poppy Appeal - The children will be selling poppies at pick up time until Tuesday 11th November. If you would like to purchase one please bring in some change. There are also items for children to buy, these range from wrist bands and reflector poppies at £1 each or snap bands at £1.50.



Flu Immunisations - These will be taking place on Thursday afternoon of next week, if you want your child to have the vaccine they can only do so if you have completed the online consent. School Meals Christmas Dinner - Due to the Christmas play being on Wednesday 10th December, Chartwells have offered to serve our Christmas dinner on Thursday 11th December. In order for them to plan in advance how many they are catering for and order the produce, they need to know how many they are catering for by Friday of next week. Could you please speak to your child/children regarding this (so that they know if they are allowed to have it) as we will be taking meal options next week. The meal will be the same as all other meals and only charged for if you currently pay. They can choose from roast turkey or Quorn roast.

Individual and Family Photographs - Hatchbox Photography will be coming to school to take individual and family photographs on Friday 21st November. To ensure they can take a photograph of your child/children you will need to have completed the 'School Photo' consent on Arbor.

Bikeability - The first session will take place on Monday of next week, this will be for Praa Sands children who have had parental consent to take part.

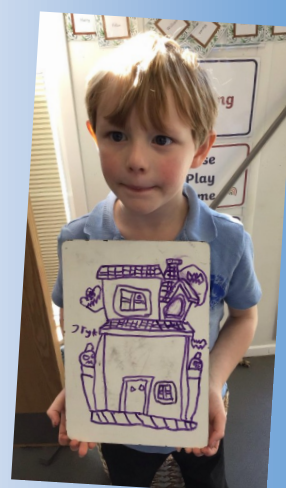
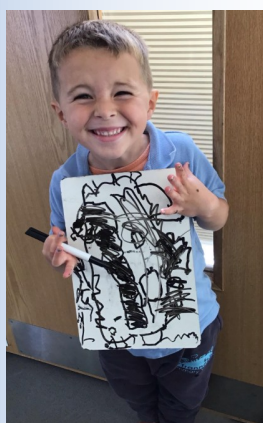

- **Annual Consent Form** - When you get chance we would really appreciate it if you could complete the new online version of this form which was posted on Dojo earlier this week. This will enable you to give consent for your child to take part in forest school activities, swimming sessions, watch PG or U rated films etc. <https://forms.cloud.microsoft/e/4BUhe8g7MF>
- **Flu Immunisations** - These will take place during the afternoon of Thursday 13th November. You can also click the link here which will take you to the application for consent: <https://www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu> You will also need this code to access the form: EE144003.
- **Photograph Consent** - It would be most helpful if you could take a little time to log into Arbor to choose your photograph consents. The school photographer will be coming in on 21st November and will be unable to take photographs of children unless consent has been given. We are also unable to post photos of children on Dojo without your consent.
- **Bikeability** - We have been very fortunate to have been offered free Bikeability sessions for all children in YrR to Yr6. This training programme has been supported and funded by the Department for Transport. The course builds skills and confidence for all children and doesn't cost you anything. If you would like your child to take part, you will need to complete the online form by Friday 24th October. Bikes and/or helmets can be provided if needed. If you are having difficulty with the form please let me know.
- **Year 5/6 Residential** - If you are planning on your child attending the residential in June 2026 at Porthpean Outdoor Education Centre, St Austell, please ensure that you have completed the 'expression of Interest' form. The trip will cost £210, a £50 non-refundable deposit will be required by February 2026.

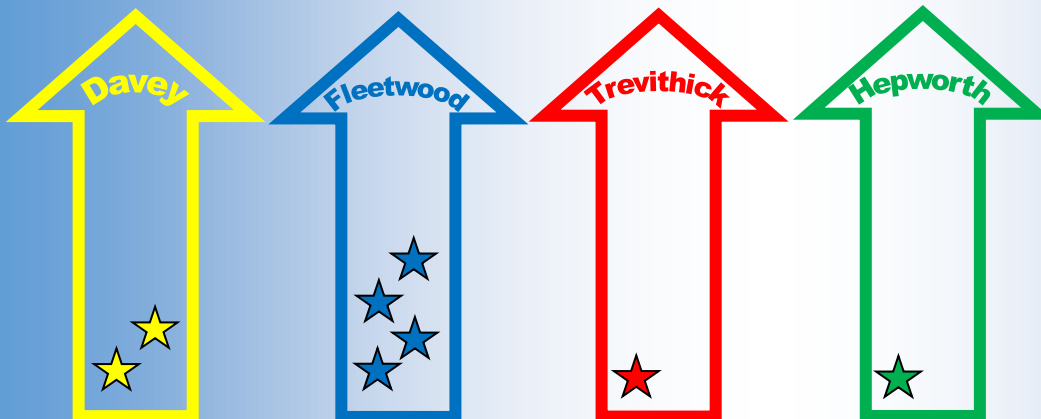

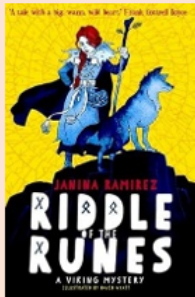

by Janina Ramirez

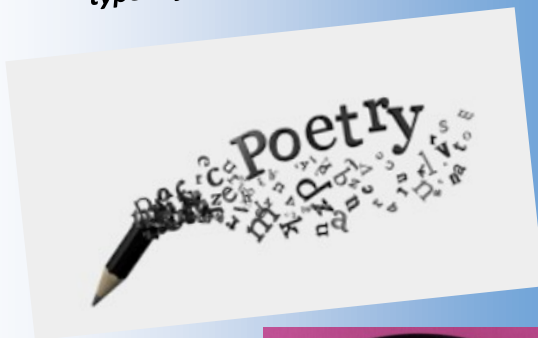

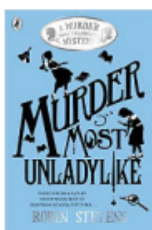
