We love Christmas at Trannack, and have many events planned to help everyone get into the Christmas spirit!


Christmas Postbox - This will be open on Monday 1st December for children to post their Christmas cards to their friends.

The Poppy Appeal - This year we raised £10.47 towards this cause.









A DT Lesson for Praa Sands Class




