## CHRISTMAS EVENTS:

**We love Christmas at Trannack, and have many events planned to help everyone get into the Christmas spirit!**

- **Christmas Postbox** - This will be open on Monday 1st December for children to post their Christmas cards to their friends.
- **Christmas Play—Midwife Crisis:**
  - \* Tuesday 9th December - rehearsals taking place during the afternoon at Helston Light & Life (Water-Ma-Trout, Helston, TR13 0LW), therefore children will need a packed lunch on this day and they will also need to be collected from Light & Life at 3:15pm.

During a DT lesson, Praa Sands class were learning to describe where fruits and vegetables grow and practising food preparation skills.





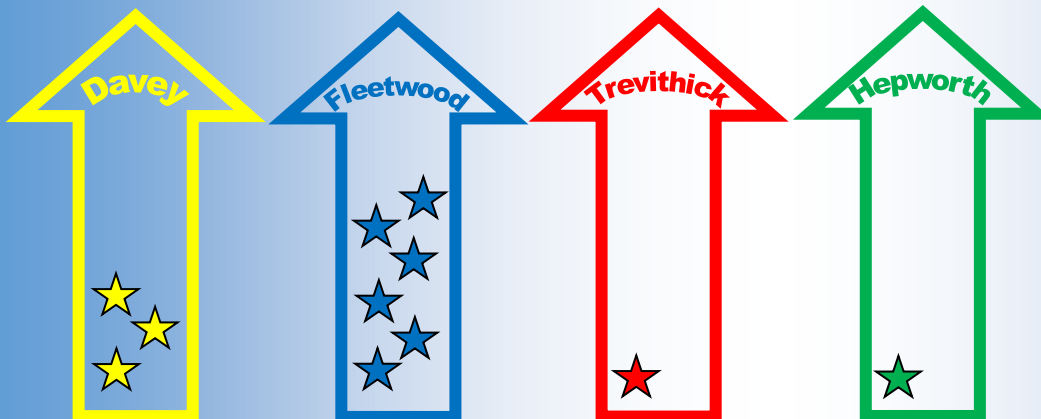

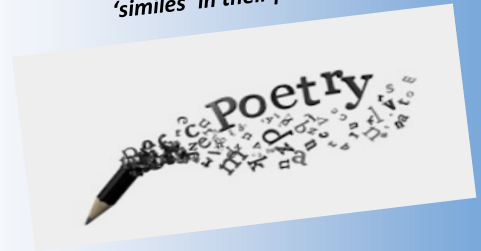


### Book Breakfast

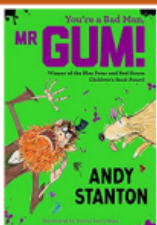


### Storytime Online
