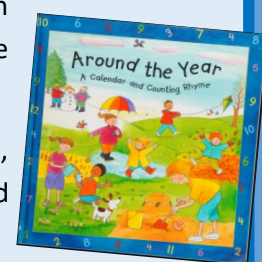

*The children had great fun at Lego League on Tuesday! Their robot programming is progressing really well!*



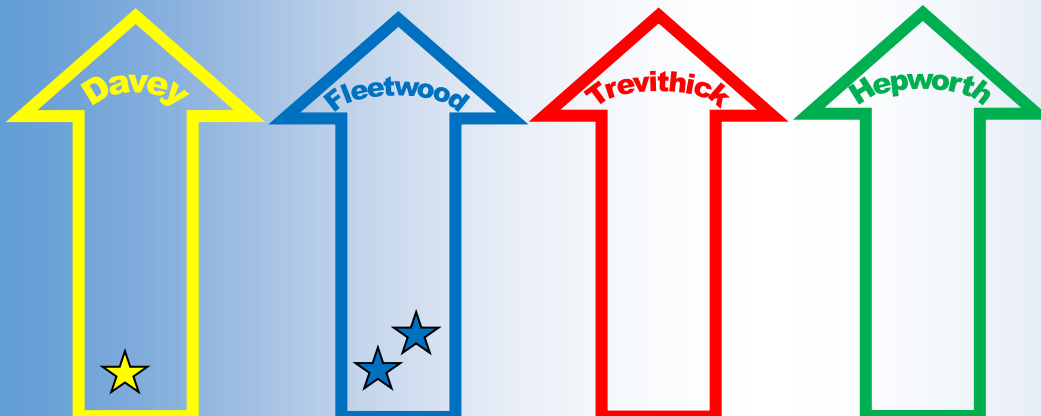
