As part of Praa Sands' science projects this week, the children made their own birds' nests. Afterwards they went up to the environmental area to place them in woodland.



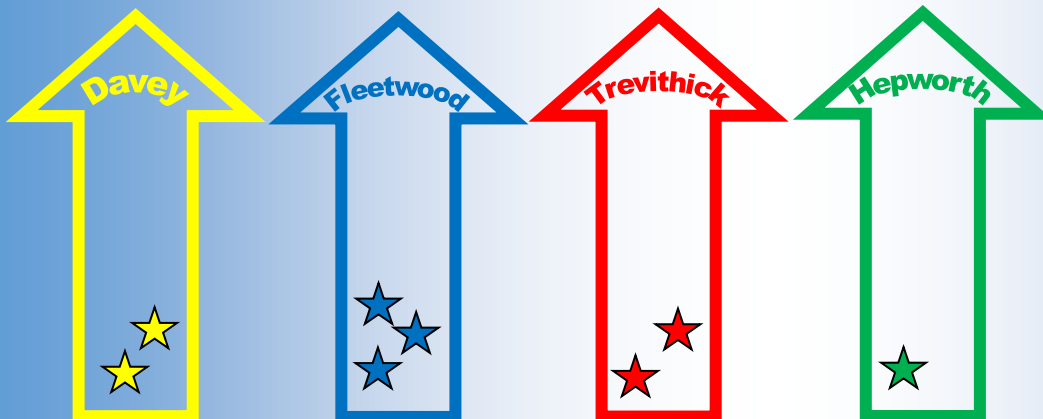

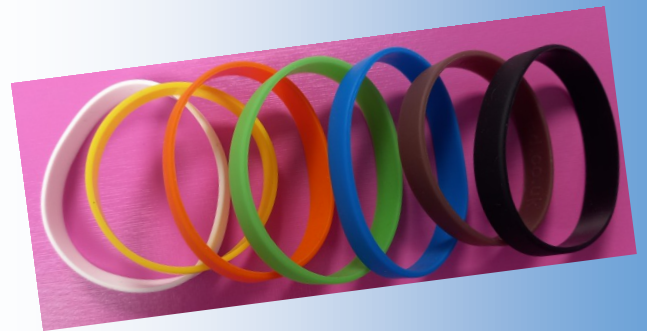
