


Dear parent(s),



Swimming Sessions - Godrevy class had the first of their five swimming sessions this Friday. The last session will take place on March 27th. 



This event is a great fundraiser for us, it will take place during the morning of Saturday 21st March.

In Science this week we tested a variety of materials to find out if they are absorbent or impermeable. We had to be very careful when using our pipettes and use the same number of drops each time!






