This week in a Godrevy art lesson, the children tried sculpting using bars of soap and sculpting tools. Their inspiration came from Barbra Hepworth.



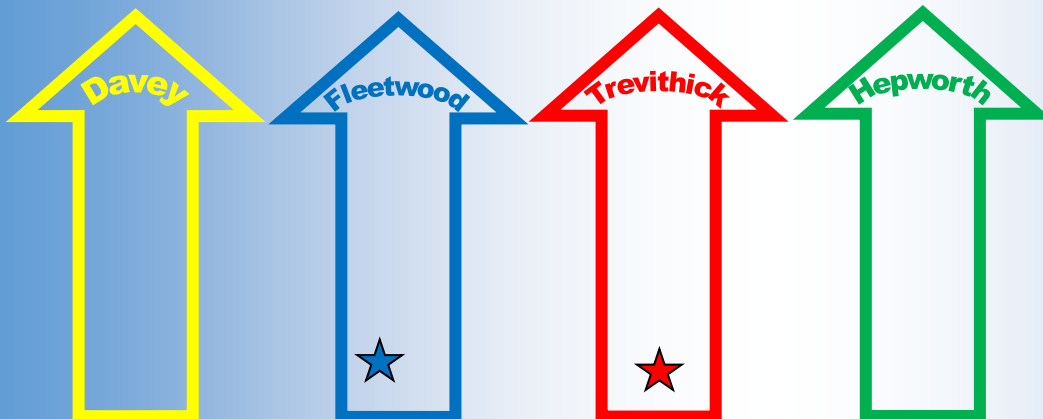

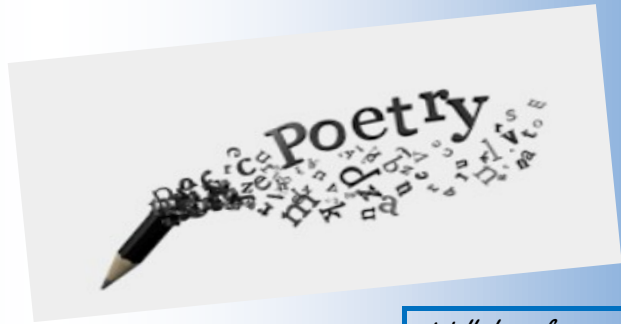

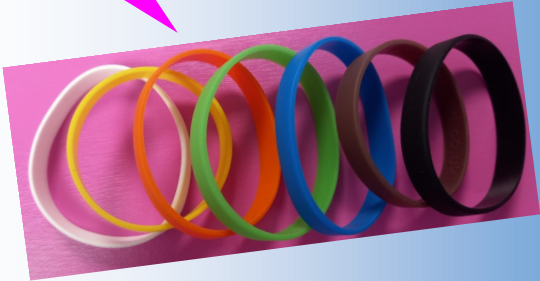
