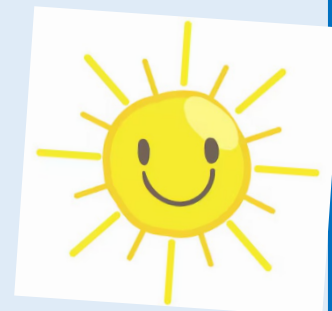
Incredibly we are halfway through the summer term already. It's been a short but eventful 5 weeks. Here are some of the highlights:

 - Dark grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
 - Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
