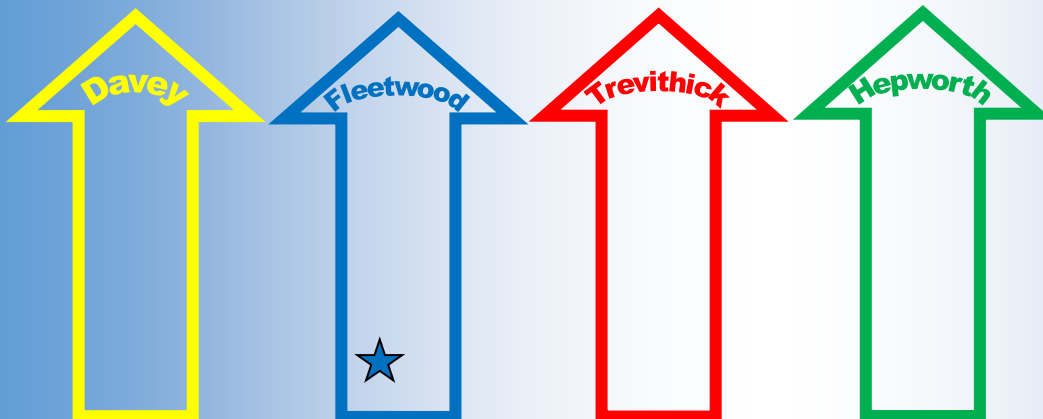

Well done for reading four times this week!

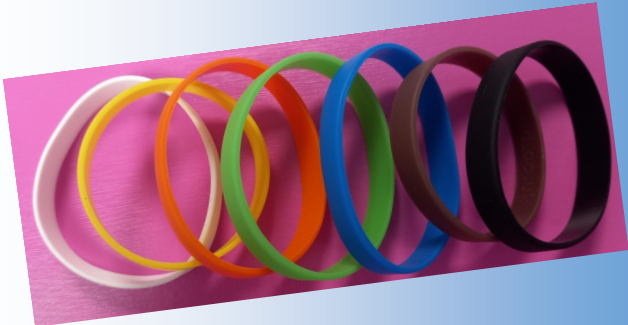
