In their art lesson this week, Godrevy class chose and joined a variety of materials to produce a sculpture.



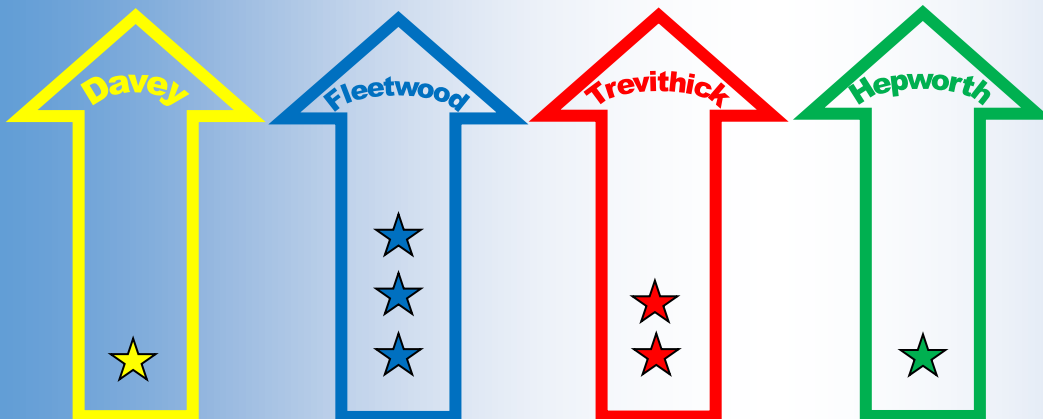

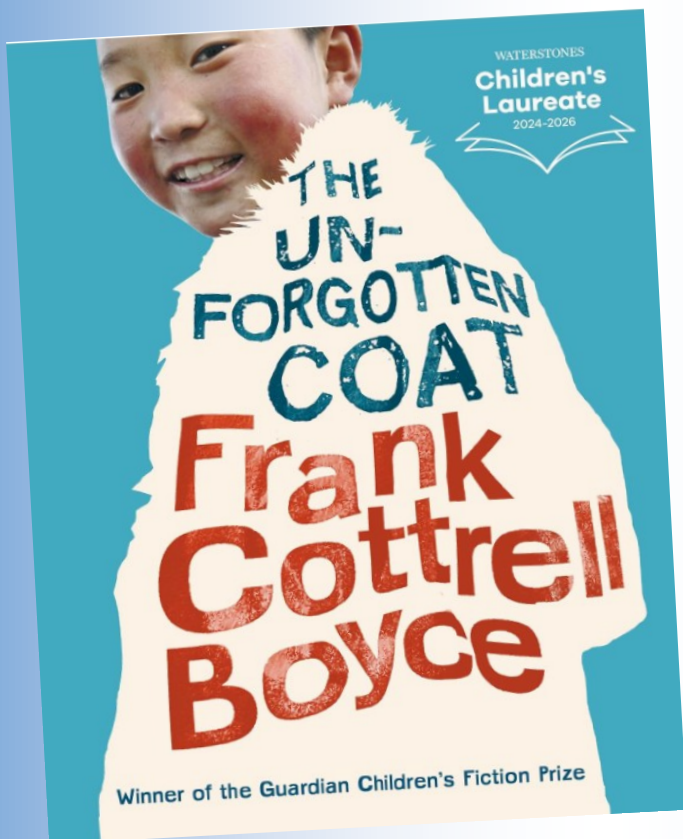

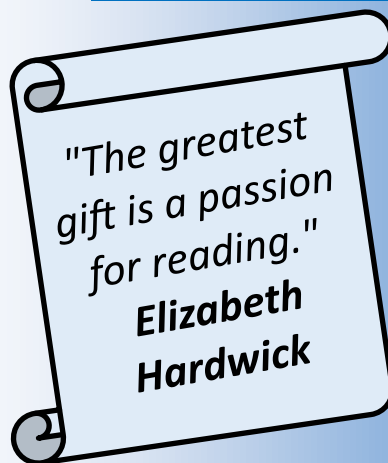
Godrevy Class are enjoying reading the 'Unforgotten Coat' by Frank Cottrell Boyce

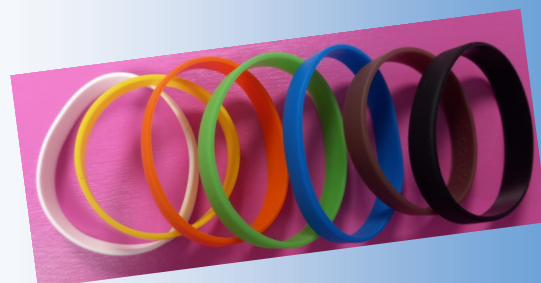

- Dark grey or black trousers (no leggings please), uniform/tailored shorts
- Dark grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- White or grey socks/grey tights
- Plain black shoes (no crocs, sandals, etc)
- PE kit (to be worn on PE days): royal blue Trannack hoodie, sky-blue t-shirt (preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms.
