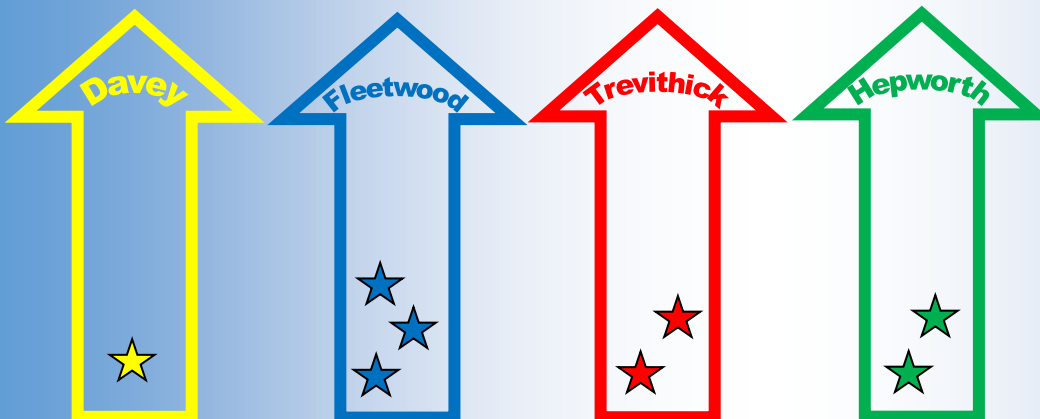
Rowan in Godrevy ~ Learner of the week for showing great resilience during our surf day and having a go at everything!

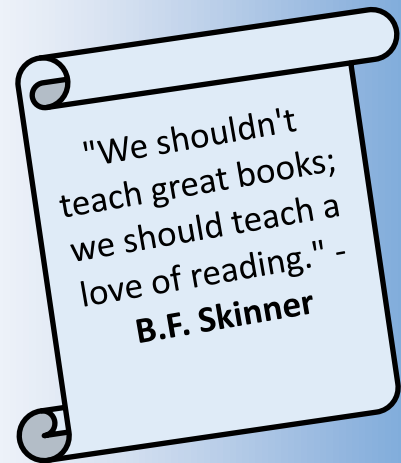
Praa Sands class are enjoying reading 'The Magic Paintbrush' by Julia Donaldson

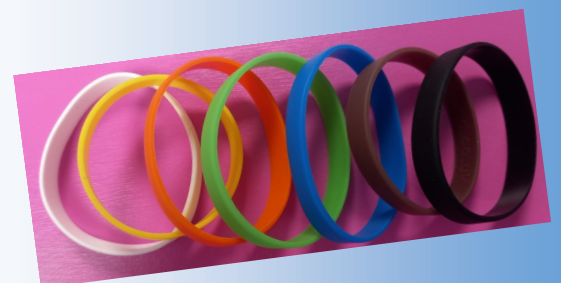

- Dark grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue gingham dress (May-September only)
- White or grey socks/grey tights
- Plain black shoes (no crocs, sandals, etc)
- PE kit (to be worn on PE days): royal blue Trannack hoodie, sky-blue t-shirt (preferably with the Trannack logo), navy blue shorts or jogging bottoms.
