The Jungle Gym (Trim Trail) - The children have already been enjoying the new trim trail and we had an 'official' unveiling during our celebration yesterday. Once again, we would like to say a BIG thank you to everyone who has contributed to the fundraising for this wonderful new play equipment, including the Lowertown Community Group, who donated £777 towards it as Trannack was the local charity/good cause which they were supporting this year.



ParentPay Invoices - Invoices for Wrap Around Care for last half term have been added to ParentPay ready for payment. Thank you!

School Meal Prices - The cost of a school meal has increased to £2.94 as of Monday 7th September. The additional charge of 14p per meal (for Mon - Weds this week) has been added to your child's ParentPay account if this is relevant to you. It wasn't until Thursday morning that we realised that parents hadn't been informed and also that the price on ParentPay was incorrect. Please accept our apologies for this oversight.



Bikeability - Yr5/6 children have once again been invited to take part in Bikeability. There will be two sessions, one on Thursday 24th September and the second session taking place on Thursday 1st October. If your child wishes to take part you will need to register them online using the following link: <https://consent.bikeability.org.uk/nun-lib-why>, stating on the consent whether or not your child needs to borrow a bike or helmet. Please make the application as soon as possible to secure a place.

Flu Immunisations - Kernow Health will once again be delivering the annual nasal flu vaccination to primary children across Devon and Cornwall on behalf of NHS England. They will be visiting Trannack on Thursday 1st October. You will need to **'Opt in'** to give consent for your child to have the immunisation, this must be done by 10am on 29th September 2026. Please see the attachments on the last two pages of this newsletter, where you will find further information and the code to access the site to give consent.

School Meal Ordering - ***This system is now up and running!*** Thank you to everyone who has managed to order their child/children's meals via ParentPay this week. If you are still struggling please try and follow these instructions: log into the child's account who you wish to order a meal for, you should see an option to book meals. The children had great fun trying out the new 'Jungle Gym' (trim trail) this week.



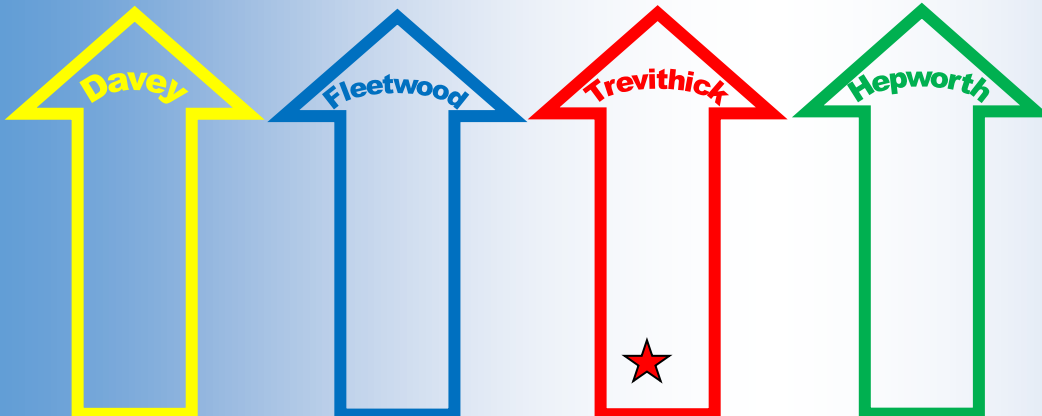

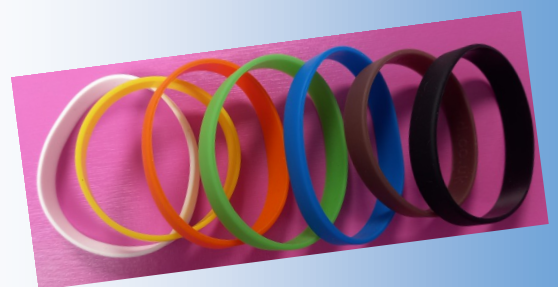
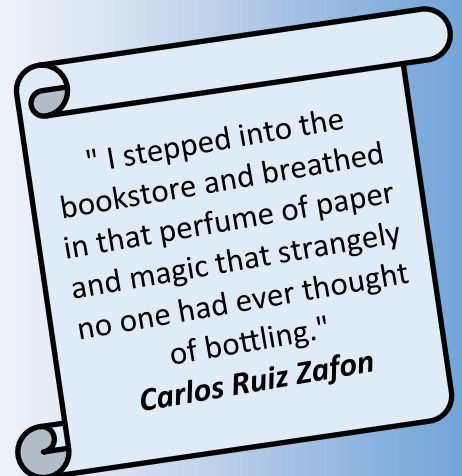


Godrevy Class are reading *Illustrated Stories from the Greek Myths* this half term.

Dear Parent/Guardian

Your child's annual nasal flu vaccination is now due

Kernow Health CIC's School Age Immunisation Service will be delivering the annual nasal flu vaccination programme in schools across Cornwall and Devon on behalf of NHS England.

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and may lead to serious complications. Vaccinating your child not only protects them but also helps prevent the spread of flu to more vulnerable friends and family members. The flu vaccine is a quick, painless spray administered into each nostril and is known as LAIV (Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine.)

Who Is Eligible?

For the 2026/27 season, all children from Reception to Year 11 will be offered the free nasal flu vaccine.

Important Reminders

- You must **opt in** for your child to receive the vaccine. Without a submitted consent form, your child will not be vaccinated.
- If your child becomes wheezy or their asthma medication is increased after submitting the form, please contact us immediately.
- If you choose not to vaccinate your child, we kindly ask that you still complete the form, selecting the "no" consent option, and provide your reason. This helps us improve the service.
- **If you have submitted a yes consent but have since changed your mind, please call us on one of the numbers above so that we can change the consent**
- If you need this information in a different format or require communication support, please let us know.
- Your child may be able to self-consent to receive the vaccine if they are considered competent to do so. This is called **Gillick competence**. For more information: [NHS Children and young people - consent to treatment](#)
