Godrevy Class Visit to Truro Museum - Next Tuesday Godrevy class will be attending an exciting afternoon workshop at Royal Cornwall Museum in Truro, to support their learning about Ancient Greece. This week they have practised using their hands and tools to shape clay in different ways and experimented with mark making using everyday objects.



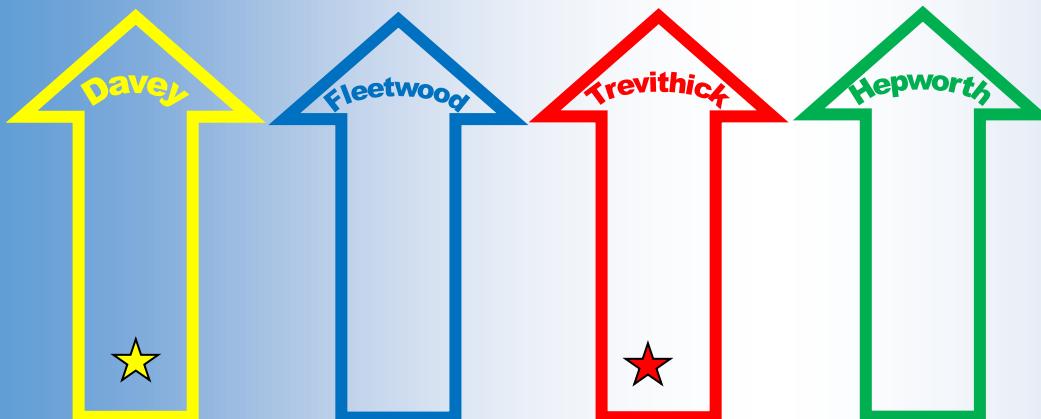

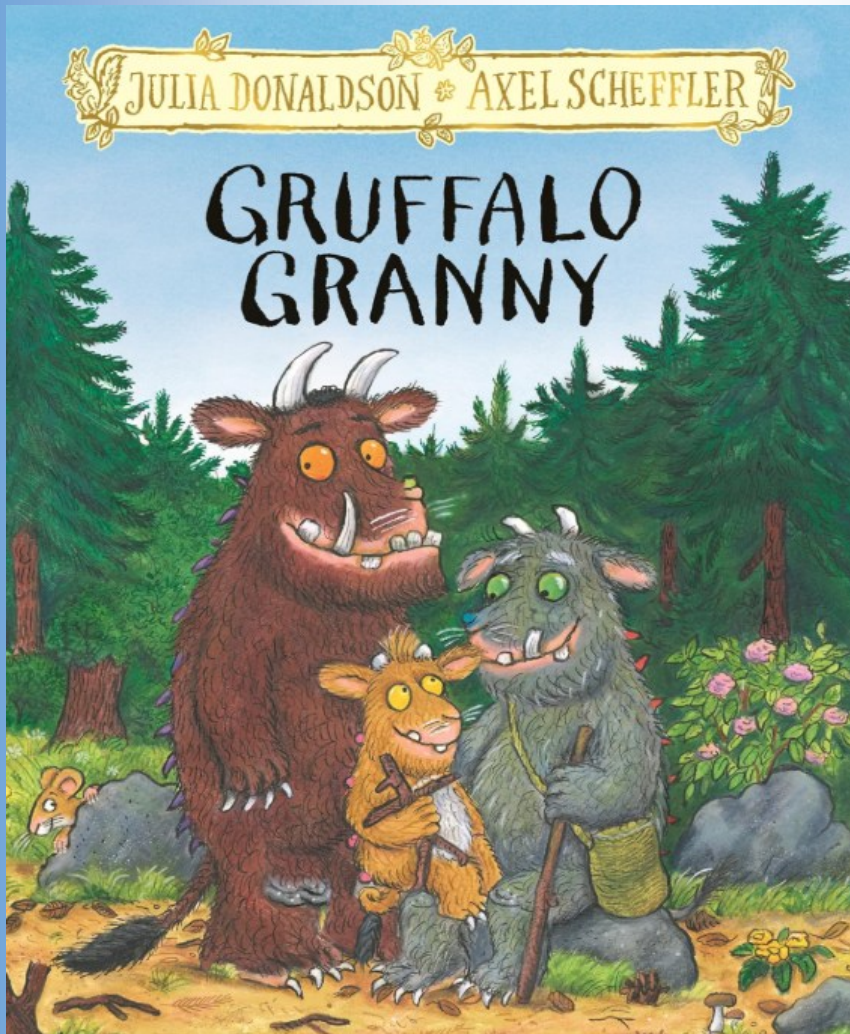

Praa Sands class have been listening to a variety of stories this week. The one they were most excited about was 'Gruffalo Granny' by Julia Donaldson.



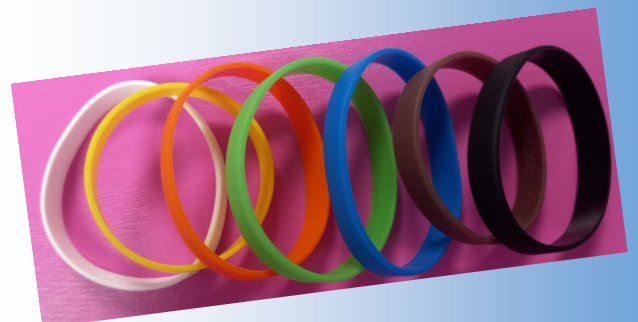
